 <p>Check screen for damage (fail if &gt;40mm or &gt;10mm in swept area ahead of driver). Inspect wiper blade condition and top up screen-wash.</p>	 <p>Verify functioning of vehicle horn.</p>	 <p>Check fuel and oil levels sufficient for MOT test centre procedure.</p>	 <p>Transfer vehicle to test centre using agreed method. Wait with vehicle, observe test procedure and fulfil return transport to storage facility.</p>	 <p>Wash and dry exterior, vacuum interior, dress dash/trim, polish glasswork and reset tyre pressures to 50psi. Return to storage bay, reconnect battery conditioner and seal Airchamber.</p>	 <p>Notify customer of test result, any advisories issued and next steps required. Log all documentation to vehicle storage history file.</p>
